



KOHL CENTER / LABAHN ARENA TOUR GUIDELINES

Tour Start:

Tour groups should enter the Kohl Center at Gate B utilizing the farthest right-hand door. Tour guides will meet the group inside the door. The Kohl Center address is 601 W Dayton Street. Gate B is to the West of Gate A and across from LaBahn Arena.

Please allow sufficient time to arrive and be ready to start promptly at the assigned time. All participants must be present at the beginning of the tour. Do not arrive more than 15 minutes prior to the assigned start time as our tour guides will not be ready for your group. Your tour window is 1 hour from the scheduled tour start time. **If your group arrives late your tour will be shortened or canceled** at the discretion of the UW Athletics Tour Staff.

Groups / Chaperones:

If arriving in multiple groups, each group should have a copy of the tour confirmation and guidelines.

Chaperones are responsible for the proper supervision of groups while touring the Kohl Center / LaBahn Arena and must take responsibility for participants' behavior on the tour. Tour guides will not act as chaperones. Chaperones are responsible for minimizing excessive talking, cell phone usage, lagging behind and/or any actions that are dangerous or inappropriate for all participants during the tour.

Tour Expectations:

- Cell phones should be silenced or turned off. Out of respect for the tour guide and the other group members, participants should not be on cell phones during the tour.
- **It is important for the group (students and adults) to be orderly, respectful, attentive and quiet.** Participants should remain with the group at all times.
- The tour guides have the right to end the tour early if the group is not cooperative or inappropriate behavior occurs. They will be asked to leave immediately. Furthermore, the UW Athletic Department reserves the right to deny future visits based on past behavior.
- There are no lunch facilities available at the Kohl Center / LaBahn Arena.
- In accordance with **Athletic Department policy**, all UW team locker rooms, basketball floor, and ice rinks are off limits to the public, including tour participants.
- Photos are permitted of the places throughout the tour other than the weight room and of student-athletes, coaches, or staff.

Parking:

City Meters:

Frances Street and Lake Street (\$2/hr., 2hr. limit - some take credit cards)

Campus Garage/Ramp Parking:

Lot 46 – 301 N. Lake Street (\$2.00/hr. pay station)

Lot 83 – 314 N. Frances St. – Under the Fluno Center (\$2.00/hr. pay station)

Lot 29 – 21 N. Park Street (\$2.00/hr. pay station)

Surface Lot 91 / MMSD Administration Lot - Requires a permit at all times. This lot does not have visitor parking.

*Campus meters are paid through the ParkMobile app or by calling the number on the sign and using a credit card.

*Campus parking violations for not paying the meter, expired meter, parking without a permit, and parking in an unauthorized area range from \$30-\$50.
